Singlebrook recertified as a B Corp in 2013. B Corp certification means we are part of a growing movement of 900+ companies competing to be the best in the world and the best for the world. The bi-annual audit of our sustainability practices resulted in a score of 111 (a passing score is 80). Paying more than a Living Wage to all employees, along with our work in the community and with purpose-driven clients, were key factors in achieving certification.

We received the Tompkins County Chamber of Commerce ReBusiness Award for our recycling, composting and upcycling practices.

Singlebrook banks locally with Alternatives Federal Credit Union, whose mission is, "to build wealth and create economic opportunity for underserved people and communities." We also have savings with RSF Loan Fund.


