Drupal Theming Pain Points

- Default markup
- Theming must wait until there's something to theme!
- CSS changes can break already styled stuff!

Default markup

```

One Possible Solution

- Style it first!
- Show it to your client! (and get approval)
- Build it in Drupal!
- Bend Drupal markup to your will!
- Looks good automagically!
- !!!

Various Styleguide Solutions

All have something in common: You don't even need Drupal to build your styleguide.

- KSS (specifically the [node port](#))
- Stylex <http://www.darrenmothersele.com/blog/2015/03/20/stylex-prototype-style-guide-tool/>

Let's try this right within Drupal.

- Clean install of Drupal
- With required modules
 - [styleguide](#) + [styleguide_filesnippets](#)
- Create and style a [component](#)
- Custom theme ([bootstrap](#) subtheme)
- Import some [test content](#)
- Implement theme changes

Demo: Modules and Theme

```
$ drush en styleguide_filesnippets
```

Now go configure file snippets directory.

```
$ drush dl bootstrap-7.x-3.x-dev
```

```
$ drush bootstrap-subtheme "CU Drupal Camp"
```

Set this new theme as default. We're gonna cheat a bit and use the Bootstrap CSS to save time.

Add this markup to `Components/News Listing.html` in the styleguide snippets directory.

Demo: Sample Content

```
$ drush en feeds-7.x-2.x-dev
```

```
$ drush en feeds_xpathparser feeds_tamper
```

- Sample importer: <https://gist.github.com/jeffam/41d4e9fbf322bdac6002>
- This step replaces a longer process of defining a content type, adding fields, and generating test content.

Theme it: Template suggestion

Add to `template.php`:

```
/**
 * Implements hook_preprocess_node().
 */
function cu_drupal_camp_preprocess_node(&$vars) {
  // Make "node--NODETYPE--VIEWMODE.tpl.php" templates available for nodes
  $vars['theme_hook_suggestions'][] = 'node__' . $vars['type'] . '__' .
  $vars['view_mode'];
}
```

Adds a new [template suggestion](#) for node view modes.

Theme it: Template suggestion (pt 2)

Add to templates/node--article--teaser.tpl.php:

```
<div class="media">
  <div class="media-left">
    <?php print render($content['field_image']); ?>
  </div>
  <div class="media-body">
    <h4 class="media-heading" <?php print $title_attributes; ?>><a href="<?php print
$node_url; ?>"><?php print $title; ?></a></h4>
    <?php hide($content['links']); ?>
    <?php print render($content); ?>
  </div>
</div>
```

Template Theming Pros and Cons

- ✓ Style in one place: home page, taxonomy, and Views content listings all look the same
- More effort
- Depends on site structure, so it's good to keep your fields and content types in features
- Litters your theme with template files
